A fee for this demand may be collected. This shall be collected in the same manner as arrears. The determination of its amount must have the approval of the imperial chancellor. Par. 3. Arrears shall be considered as preferred debts as specified in article 61, No. 1, of the Code on Bankruptcy (Konkursordnung). Article 228. Paragraph 1. The claim to arrears lapses in two years after the expiration of the calendar year when due: Provided, That the payments are not purposely defaulted. Par. 2. The claim for repayment of contributions lapses in six months after the expiration of the calendar year in which they have been paid, subject, however, to the provisions of...
